Paso-Primerero started in 2015. After a decade of making and selling wines around the world for other people, we went to Spain looking for somewhere to build our own business from scratch. To do this we needed to find some like-minded souls who were mad enough to open their winery doors, share our vision and help us fulfil our dream. In Somontano we found Batan de Salas and the rest is history. Well, not quite. It's taken years of hard work, dedication and unwavering passion to get to this point. This isn't a range of wines thrown together for a quick sale. We live and breathe every single one of our wines. We pour every ounce of passion we have into every bottle to make sure they aren't corporate concoctions but wines with purpose. Wines that capture moments and bring a bit of joy back to drinking wine. That's what made us fall in love with wine in the first place and that's what we always try to emulate with Paso-Primerero. Wines should be fun and we hope ours are too. We certainly have a lot of fun making them.

The Pasotismo collection is a range of wines built out of a passion for sharing great wines with even better people, and the result of an extraordinary, life-affirming collaboration.

In 2015 Batan de Salas took a chance on us and allowed us to pursue our dream of making our own wines, in our own way. That first dream was Paso-Primero but after years of working in the same winery, breaking bread over long lunches and having heated debates with cold beers, it was inevitable that we'd start talking about a collaboration project. Not a paint-by-numbers, hedge-fund managed, conceptual lifestyle brand collaboration. A genuine coming together of winemaking families with a common goal to make wines we love and are proud to have on our table.

From that simple goal the Pasotismo project has gone on to completely revolutionise our approach to farming and winemaking. We have become the most viticulturally dynamic winery in the whole of Somontano, working tirelessly to re-establish indigenous varieties and farm sustainably despite increased climatic demands. The growing list of achievements is only matched by our continually evolving ambitions and thanks to the Pasotismo collaboration we are creating wines that have redefined what our region can produce.

Our Pasotismo collaboration series currently contains three wines; Pasotismo Tinto, Pasotismo Blanco and Moristel '76.

Each one represents a different journey we've taken to find the very best that Somontano has to offer.

From our version of the big, juicy, international reds that gave this region global renown, to a white of unequivocal elegance and finesse, and our flagship foray into an indigenous variety that's capturing the wine world's imagination. These wines are redefining what can be achieved in our little patch of northern Spain.



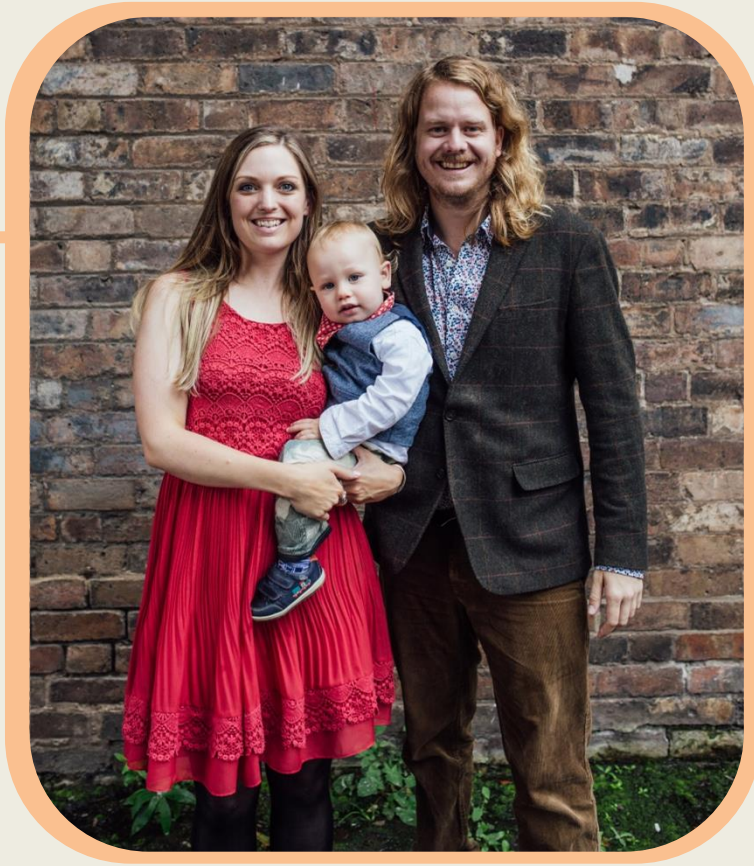

We are constantly trying to explore the potential of Somontano and push the limits of the region's quality. Part of this project has meant re-establishing indigenous varieties and figuring out ways to unlock their idiosyncrasies to make unique wines with our trademark 'Paso-drinkability'.
